Department Highlights

Press Releases

- Deputy Libby has requested a warrant for his suspect in the forgery complaint, from January.
- Deputy Wacome is investigating another forgery case, very similar to the one that Deputy Libby handled last month. In both cases a check was manufactured, and forged. There are separate person's involved with the cashing of the checks at a local business. This time the manufactured check was made to look like it came from a local business (the last one was out of Fairfield).
- There was a surge of scam calls involving the IRS, this seemed to be state wide where a lot of agencies dealt with the same issues. Thankfully of all the complaints that were fielded in Madison, none resulted with residents giving out any personal information.
- Madison Division Deputies assisted the State Fire Marshall's office with executing a search warrant involving 2 adult males, and 1 Juvenile female, for arson and burglary. The arson took place in Anson, and resulted in the loss of a home. All subjects were arrested in Madison, where stolen items were located. At the time of the warrant, the homeowner was charged by Deputy Libby, with possessing marijuana.

Personnel

Tyler Lafreniere is in the final stages of his field training, and should be actively handling all of his own calls by the end of the month. On March 3rd three candidates were interviewed for the two vacancies on the Madison Division. As a result, Sheriff Lancaster has offered positions to green pins Chelsea Merry and Tad Nelson pending approval by the County Commissioners.

Patrol Coverage

During the month of February, Deputies were called out three times during the overnight hours: Domestic disturbance, suspicious activity and burglar alarm.

Training / Other

The Madison Division is currently carrying both AED's and Narcan(Naloxone) ,in the cruisers. These are both life saving tools that our Deputies will have access to if needed. The no-cost use of the Narcan (Naloxone) was made possible through a partnership with RFGH, and the Sheriff's office. The training was provided by Dr. Ann Dorney.

The AED's (Automated External Defibrillator) we're acquired through a Homeland Security grant, and training was provided through Anson Madison Starks Ambulance Service).

On 2/24 Deputies took a limited access training in order to run the Metro system for license & registration checks.
