Department Highlights

Press Releases

On January 8th, Deputy Craig Dyer Conducted an Impaired Driving Detail as an overtime shift. This detail was funded through a grant awarded by the Bureau of Highway Safety. This particular detail focused on Lakewood Road, White School House Road, and Main Street. The detail was to be conducted between the hours of 10PM – 2AM. During the detail Deputy Dyer conducted three motor vehicles stops which resulted in:

- Warning for a tail light being out
- Warrant arrest
- Arrest for Operating Under the Influence (OUI)

On January 28th Sheriff Lancaster, Patrol Staff Sergeant Knight, Corporal Cole, and Deputy Dyer assisted the Elementary school with a lockdown drill. In a meeting immediately following the drill, policies and procedures were reviewed and corrective actions were discussed with Principal Scott Mitchell.

Deputy Libby is currently investigating an aggravated forgery case involving the manufacturing of a bank note (check), and will result in charges of unauthorized taking and transfer. A suspect has been identified but no charges have been filed.

Personnel

No new personnel to report in January. Deputy Libby and Deputy Morris are doing an outstanding job becoming familiar with their new patrol area and conducting investigations. Deputy Tyler LaFreniere is in the process of field training and is expected to complete this training by the end of February. Deputy Dyer accepted a position with the rural patrol starting on February 14th.

Patrol Coverage

During the month of January, patrol was called out five times during the overnight hours . This consisted of Motor Vehicle accident, Motor Vehicle Complaints (suspended driver information) Verbal altercation, 9-1-1 Misdeal, and Animal Complaint (that came via 9-1-1)

Training / Other

The new policy for the Administering of the Intranasal Naloxone is complete and issued by the Sheriff. Deputies will have access to Intranasal Naloxone kits in the cruisers in the near future.

Through grant funding the Sheriff has purchased two AED's (Automated External Defibrulators) for the Madison patrol vehicles. The AED's will be placed in the vehicles in the near future.
