Press Releases

On Thursday, November 5th, the Sheriff's Office led a team of 7 deputies and an MDEA agent on a search warrant executed on Blackwell Hill Road in Madison. The search warrant resulted in the confiscation of approximately 1,100 bags (120 grams) of heroin, 20 grams of cocaine, other drugs, \$6,400 in cash, and vehicles. Jeremy Fitzmorris of Madison has been charged with aggravated trafficking of heroin.

Personnel

John Morris and Lucas Libby have begun their field training with Deputy Ron Blodgett and Deputy Toby Blodgett. Both John and Lucas will continue their field training into December.

The position of Administrative Assistant has been filled. Sharon Carey started with the Madison Division on November 23rd and will be training with Stacey Slate until the first week of December.

Patrol Coverage

During the month of November patrol was called out during the overnight hours 16 times. The reasons for callouts include; harassment, domestic disturbances, non-injury accidents, suspicious activity, burglar alarms, unattended deaths, assisting an individual at the office, theft, and a 911 misdial.

Training / Other

The Sheriff's Office used grant funds to purchase nine Glock holsters. This is in preparation for the departments conversion from H&K handguns to Glock.
