

Town of Madison, Business Revitalization 2019 Matching Grant Program

- The Matching Grant Program is a local business assistance program funded by Tax Increment Financing (TIF) Funds at a rate not to exceed \$50,000 per year.
- The program is specifically designed for business properties that exist within the Town of Madison.
- **Businesses must be paid up to date on both Real Estate and Personal Property Taxes before receiving cash payout for award.**
- The purpose of the program is to stimulate spending by businesses for economic development, and to assist business owners with projects designed for site improvements that will enhance their business. Projects will NOT be funded retroactively. Projects must start and finish after the award date.
- Each grant is a 50/50 match up to a maximum award of \$5,000.
- Eligible businesses can only receive one grant during the program calendar year.
- Employees of the Town of Madison and spouses are not eligible. Elected Town Select Board Officials and their immediate family are not eligible.

Application Process

There will be an open application periods with up to \$25,000 to be granted. The application period runs from June 10, 2019 through July 17, 2019.

Completed applications must be received at the Town Office by 4pm on Wednesday July 17, 2019. Late or incomplete applications will not be processed.

Applications are reviewed by the Town Manager. Then, recommended proposals are brought to the Board of Selectmen for review and scoring. Businesses will be notified of the results by 4pm Wednesday July 24, 2019.

Funding Process

Business must accept award within 30 days. Unaccepted funds will be added to the pool for the next application period.

Invoices for work performed must be submitted by the business for funding.

Grant funding for approved applicants will be paid out upon completion of the project. Please allow up to 60 days for payment.

Projects not completed within 1 year of approval date will not be funded.

Businesses that receive monies for completed projects but do not open or go out of business will be subject to repayment of funds at a rate of 75% for the first 12 months, and 50% within the first 24 months of receiving the funds.
