What can I recycle?

- *Steel, Tin, Aluminum Cans
- *Plastic Bottles and Containers

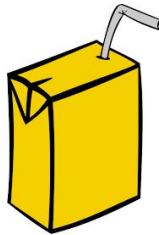
- #1: Disposable Beverage and Food Containers
- #2: Milk Jugs, Detergent and Cooking Oil Bottles
- #5: Empty Medicine Bottles and some Stiffer plastic

*Office paper, Brown paper bags, Newspaper, Magazines, & Junk Mail

- *Paper Cardboard Dairy & Juice Containers
- *Flattened Cardboard and Paperboard

*Glass Bottles and Jars

* To check the type of plastic you have look on the bottom of the container and there should be a number.



What Can't I recycle?

- * Food and Liquids
- * Electronics & Small Appliances
- *Textiles, Bedding, Rugs, and Carpet
- * Hoses, Holiday Lights & Hangers
- * Plastic Bags and Film Sheeting
- * Paper Napkins, Plates, & Cups
- * Foam to-go Containers
- * Tires, Auto Parts, & Scrap Metal
- *Concrete, Wood, and Debris
- * Medical Waste

* Most of these items will either break the machines or cause the workers harm.

All containers previously containing food must have no food residue prior to recycling.
