

Town of Madison Mowing/Trimming Bids

The Town of Madison is requesting 2-year bids for each of the below numbered locations for mowing and lawn maintenance from **January 2026 - December 2027** including spring and fall clean up.

- 1) **Forest Hills Cemetery;**
- 2) **Other town cemeteries;** 10 smaller cemeteries;
- 3) **Town-owned properties;** 26 Weston Avenue, Old Point Avenue facility, Main Street park and playground, Thomas Street field, and the Nathan Street boat landing area; and
- 4) **Other Town properties;** 3 properties AS NEEDED 4 to 6 times per year: Clough's Corner island (Rt 148 & Rt 201), Father Rasle Rd island, and Town sign (on Rt 201 near the Madison Town line).

Mowing and trimming schedules will vary at each job site. Job specifications are available at the Town Office, on the town website www.madisonmaine.com, or by emailing the Town Manager at townmanager@madisonmaine.com.

Each cemetery must be maintained per Maine Statute Title 13 § 1101 – which reads as follows: “keep the grass, weeds and brush suitably cut and trimmed on graves from May 1st to September 30th of each year.” Penalties for late performance of this requirement may be imposed by the Town.

Bids are due by Noon on Thursday, April 24, 2025.
