

Job Posting Road Commissioner

The Town of Madison is seeking to fill a full-time position for a Road Commissioner. The position will be appointed until the June 2023 election, thereafter will be subject to an election process.

This position is for the management of a department consisting of six full-time staff, and three seasonal employees.

The employee of this position is responsible for staffing, organizing, directing, and coordinating all phases of municipal public works, including street and sidewalk maintenance and construction, snow and ice control or removal, garage facilities, automotive and equipment maintenance and public works administration. The Road Commissioner is also the Tree Warden pertaining to trees within the road right of way.

Work involves administering departmental work priorities, planning and implementing work programs, and making difficult technical and administrative decisions. Work is performed with a high degree of independence under the general direction of the Select Board and in coordination with the Town Manager.

The ideal candidate will have considerable administrative and operational public works experience; graduation from standard high school or vocational school, supplemented by some college level course work in engineering, bookkeeping, or any equivalent combination of experience and training. Should possess a valid State of Maine Class II motor vehicle license.
