REQUEST FOR BIDS  
MADISON LIBRARY HANDICAP RAMP PROJECT

The Town of Madison is accepting sealed bids for the construction of a handicap accessible ramp and related improvements at the Madison Public Library located in Madison, Maine.

The project generally consists of furnishing all labor, materials, equipment, and services necessary for the construction of an ADA accessible handicap ramp in accordance with the project plans prepared by Nichols Draft & Craft dated May 22, 2026. The project includes, but is not limited to:

- Construction of a pressure-treated framed handicap ramp and deck
- Composite decking installation
- Vinyl railing system with ADA handrail
- Techno post installation by a certified installer
- Roof structure over entry area with standing seam roofing to match existing
- Installation of ADA accessible door and opener
- Asphalt sidewalk connection
- Landscaping, seeding, and site restoration

\*Please itemize costs for the bid.

Plans and specifications may be obtained from the Town Office or reviewed during normal business hours.

All bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope clearly marked:

“Madison Library Handicap Ramp Bid”

Bids will be accepted at the Madison Town Office, 26 Weston Avenue, Madison, Maine 04950 until 4:00 PM on June 16, 2026, at which time bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Decision on bid will take place at Select Board meeting on June 22, 2026 at 6:30PM at the OPA Meeting Room.

The Town of Madison reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, to waive any informalities in the bidding process, and to award the bid in the best interest of the Town.
